

## Chapter 256

### SIGNS AND HANDBILLS

**[HISTORY: Adopted by the Borough Council of the Borough of East Vandergrift (Ch. 1, §§ 100.1 and 100.2, of the 1977 compilation). Amendments noted where applicable.]**

#### **§ 256-1. Posting.** <sup>1</sup>

It shall be unlawful for any person to post, paste or fasten any printed, painted or written sign, showbill, placard, circular or advertisement of any description whatsoever upon any telephone, electric light pole or post or tree within the Borough of East Vandergrift.

#### **§ 256-2. Violations and penalties.** <sup>2</sup>

Any person violating the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction in a summary proceeding under the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure, be guilty of a summary offense and shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$1,000, plus court costs and reasonable attorneys' fees incurred by the Borough in the enforcement proceedings. Upon judgment against any person by summary conviction, or by proceedings by summons on default of the payment of the fine or penalty imposed and the costs, the defendant may be sentenced and committed to the county correctional facility for a period not exceeding 30 days. Each day that such violation exists shall constitute a separate offense, and each section of this chapter that is violated shall also constitute a separate offense. In addition to or in lieu of enforcement under this section, the Borough may enforce this chapter in equity in the Court of Common Pleas of Westmoreland County.
